Most Baroque sonatas such as those by Handel and Telemann; unaccompanied Fantasies by Telemann; *Folies d'Espagne* for solo flute by Marais; *Le Rossignol en amour* for flute and harpsichord by Couperin; any Romantic character piece or Theme and Variations by composers such as Donjon, Kling, Koehler, Popp, etc.; many of the solos found on the CD Sheet Music (published by Presser) are also suitable to the piccolo.

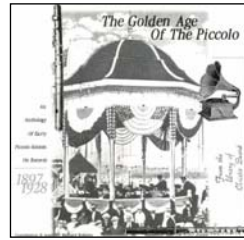

How to use this chart: Make sure you are warmed up thoroughly, then tune to your normal tuning pitch (for flute/piccolo, A2 is the best notes for tuning purposes). Tune using LITTLE or NO vibrato. Always play at a comfortable dynamic (about *mf*). Once you are in tune, play the chromatic scale, slowly in half notes or whole notes, breathing as often as necessary. Have a friend watch the tuner (where you can not see it) and have him/her log each note's pitch tendency using the symbols # or b. Keep the dynamic level and air stream steady! Refer to chart and memorize the tendencies of your particular instrument; then work to resolve those notes that are troublesome. Repeat this exercise every 6 weeks or after you feel significant progress has been made.
